State of Texas Renewable Energy Co-op (formerly Texas Power Pool) is an aggregated wholesale electricity purchase organized through the State Energy Conservation Office (SECO) utilizing Texas SmartBuy Contract 961-M2 (“the State contract”) awarded by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts Statewide Procurement Division to Texas Energy Aggregation. **Texas Energy Aggregation is releasing an RFP on behalf of interested public entities to accurately quantify opportunities currently available through aggregation.**

Goals

This opportunity is available exclusively for Texas public entities to achieve the following goals:

- Longer-term budget certainty to reduce risk and exposure to volatile energy markets
- Lowest historical fixed electricity price under 3 cents per kWh utilizing:
 - statewide aggregated purchasing power
 - best practice, transparent, competitive bidding process
 - renewable power purchase agreements
- Utilization of State and University-owned land leases to create extra value for State and educational institutions
- Acting upon market-driven opportunities available before Federal renewable energy tax credits begin ramping down by Jan. 1, 2020

Signing this letter will in no way impact any existing electricity agreements which your institution may already have in place.
